	Submit the <u>"Articles of Faith Written Assignment-English"</u> or <u>"Articles of Faith Written Assignment-</u>

	Request your senior pastor/mentor and local church board to submit written recommendations on you
	behalf. "Ministerial Candidate Recommendation Forms-English" or "Ministerial Candidate
	Recommendation Forms-Spanish" via Jot Form (If you currently serve as senior/lead pastor, the D.S.
	completes the Pastor's Recommendation and the Church Board completes their form as well.)
	Study the "Interview Guidelines" for your assigned year to prepare for your Credentials Board interview
	Complete the Online "Leading From Your Strengths Profile" (www.ministryinsights.com), and
	"CliftonStrengths" (www.gallup.com/cliftonstrengths) – to be completed one time only. Submit a copy of
	both resources to sacdist@sacnaz.org.
	Be engaged and participate in a mentoring relationship with an approved mentor.
	AFTER you submit all of the above items, you will be scheduled for a district license interview.

	any special schedule requests (work schedules, family needs). Please allow for a potentially longer period

THE INTERVIEW

- When you first arrive at the District Office, please check in with Kaitlin Peoples, Executive Assistant.
- You are encouraged to dress in business casual attire.
- You are welcome to use a printed Bible during your interview (the printed one, not the digital one).
- IF applying for Ordination (and married) we request that your spouse attend the interview with you!

1. The procedure for your interviews will include meeting with:

- a. **the Ministerial Studies Board** to **1)** review your transcripts, **2)** review courses you completed in the past year, **3)** verify your current placement within the Course of Study and **4)** review your current mentoring relationship. If you are a graduate of the course of study your interview will include an update of your ongoing academic development for ministry.
- b. **the Ministerial Credentials Board** to consider your application for a district license or ordination, and to evaluate your personal and ministry development in the past year. This is the Board who will be listening toyour presentation on the Articles of Faith and asking you the "Interview Guidelines" questions.
- **2.** As a student in the Course of Study please be ready to identify a Mentor (a local pastor or other ordained minister), with whom you have met in the past 12 months, and plan to meet in the coming 12 months, to continue developing your personal accountability & spiritual purity.
- **3.** IF you are granted your first district license in this meeting, we request that you make arrangements to attend the Ordination Service on Friday, April 26, 7:00 pm at Auburn Parkside Church, so that we may present your first District License to you.
- **4. IF for any reason** you experience significant travel delays <u>or if</u> weather conditions prohibit you from getting to your scheduled interview, please call Kaitlin Peoples immediately. If absolutely necessary we will attempt to adjust or reschedule your interview time. (916) 652-1193 x2
- **5. Please notify the district office** if you have a change of personal/contact information at any time (address; phone; email; church; assigned role, etc.).
